Prior to selling any food product, a food vendor must complete the following requirements and sign the checklist once completed.

- I have read the Department of Agriculture "Guidelines for Public Markets" found on the internet at: http://www.gov.ns.ca/agri/foodsafety/policies/publicmarketguide.shtml
- Having read the "Guidelines for Public Markets", I understand which of my products are "Schedule A" products and which are "Schedule B" products, and that I cannot sell products as noted in "Schedule C" at the Bridgewater Farmers' Market.

If selling any "Schedule A" products, I state that:

- I have spoken with the Food Safety Specialist (FSS) to determine what practices I must adhere to in order to satisfy Food Safety Regulations.
- I am adhering to these practices.
- I have applied for and received my annual Public Market Vendors Permit.
- I have asked the FSS if I should take the Food Handling course and have followed her/ his recommendation.

If selling any "Schedule B" products, I state that:

- I have spoken with the Food Safety Specialist (FSS) to determine if there are any specific practices I must adhere to in order to satisfy Food Safety Regulations.
- I have asked the FSS if I should take the Food Handling course and have followed her/ his recommendation.
