

Yiwu Sightseeing During Trade Show Apr. 26 – Apr. 30

Desheng Cliff

In 621 A.D., Yiwu was named Chouzhou and hence cliff is called Chou Cliff. The altitude of the cliff is 381.7 meters but cannot be compared with other famous mountains. Travelers can feel its ruggedness while climbing the cliff along the winding mountain road.

Octagon Hall

It is a famous construction, which embodies history, art and science, and is a miracle in Zhejiang history of ancient construction. Because of the delicate carvings, the Octagon Hall of Huangshan is also called 'the Museum of Carving Art'. These carvings are more than 190 years old and are well protected till now.

Shuanglin Iron Pagoda

It is the earliest iron pagoda existing in China now. Shuanglin Temple was opened by a hierarch named Fu Dashi in Nanliang State. Because of its great extent and hierarchy, the temple was widely known inland and abroad for centuries. Shuanglin Iron Pagoda was built by Zhu Hongji in 952 A.D.

Xiuhu Lake Park

The Park was created alongside Xiuhu Lake in 2003 and is located in the center of Yiwu City, Zhejiang Province. Covering an area of 71,643 sq.m (17.7 acres), the park has an architectural complex in the north and the east, the lake itself being a major feature. The buildings have been constructed in the architectural styles of the Ming (1368-1644) and Qing (1644-1911) dynasties.

Trip Included Tour Sites May1 – May 5

Jinhua

Tour Double-Dragon Scenic Area and visit the Double Dragon Cave. Tour Zhuge Bagua Village of Lanxi, the biggest settlement for the descendants of Zhuge Liang (a legendary politician, strategies, and diplomatist during the Three kingdoms period).

Hangzhou

Tour Six Harmonies Pagoda the 64.3 ft high Camphor-wood carved Buddha in Lingyin Temple, and Hupao Spring, Yue Fei Mausoleum, and enjoy a boat cruise on West Lake with stops at jewel-like pagodas and tea houses.

Suzhou

Full day sightseeing includes Tiger Hill, Chilly Hill Temple, and Liu Lingering Garden, an intimate refuge with fascinating views.

Shanghai

View Garden of Contentment. The five-acre garden consists of six walled sections: Grand Rockery, Ten Thousand-Flower Pavilion, Hall of Heralding Spring, Hall of Jade Magnificence, Inner Garden, and Lotus Pool. Then visit Nanjing Lu, Century Park, Lujiazui Financial District and People's Square. After Dinner, you will be taken to the Bund Area. Check out the symbolic landmark of Shanghai and the epitome of Shanghai's modern history.
