Causes of Jay's Treaty

- 1- Britain was capturing ships carrying food to French colonies in Caribbean
- 2- Britain captured hundreds of US merchant vessels
- 3- British were encouraging Natives in west to rebel and supplying them with guns
- 4- British have not abandon forts in western lands belonging to the US

Jay's Treaty Provisions-

- 1- Britain agrees to pay the US for any ships they capture in the future
- 2- Small merchant ships could continue to trade in the Caribbean
- 3- Britain promises to abandon forts in western land
- 4- US agrees to pay all debts owed to British merchants that were incurred prior to the American Revolution
