

Sheridan names new facility after departing president

Sheldon Levy may be gone, but his contributions to Sheridan College will not be forgotten.

In honour of the outgoing president, Sheridan's Board of Governors has decided to name its new Communication, Culture and Information Technology (CCIT) facility, the Sheldon Levy Centre.

After four years as president of the college, Levy has left for a position with the University of Toronto as the Vice-President of Government and Institutional Relations.

His replacement, Dr. Robert Turner, currently the President and CEO of Olds College in Alberta and Chair of the Olds College Centre for Innovation, starts sometime in the new year.

The Sheldon Levy Centre will house the new CCIT program, a joint program of Sheridan and the University of Toronto, which is scheduled to start in September, 2001.

This new program will focus on communication theory and practice, culture studies, and multimedia design and implementation.

The CCIT building will also incorporate the Technology Transfer Centre, a high-tech business incubator.

The international award-winning firm of Zeilder Roberts partnership Architects, of Toronto, has been selected to design the new CCIT facility.

The CCIT facility is one of several projects at Sheridan to receive funding from the Province of Ontario's SuperBuild Growth Fund. Funding was also approved earlier this year to enhance existing facilities for Sheridan's popular Music Theatre program and create the new Sheridan Elder Research Centre.

Zeilder Roberts Partnership has been commissioned to carry out these projects in addition to the Sheldon Levy Centre.

Luminaries will burn Christmas Eve

The luminaries will be burning in Fairway Hills this Christmas Eve.

For a ninth year in a row, Gerry and Marlene Sibbald are distributing luminaries, six-inch candles to be placed inside of brown paper bags, to be placed along the curbsides.

About 1,000 luminaries will be distributed on behalf of the Fairway Hills Community Association.

And, similar to last year, a collection will be held for the Oakville Salvation Army. Thanks to the efforts of Terry

McGibbon, about \$4,200 was collected from spectators passing through the neighbourhood at Fairway Hills Boulevard off Dorval Drive at Monastery Drive.

The candles will remain burning to about midnight, however, most of the traffic to view the luminaries is expected between 5:30 and 8:30 p.m. For best viewing, drivers should turn their lights off, says the Sibbalds.

In case of inclement weather, the luminaries will burn Christmas night.
