"God's Grace"

GRACE is a word you hear a lot in church, but what does it really mean? Grace is defined as the FREE and UNMERITED favor of God. Grace simply means not getting what you deserve. As humans we can give grace to others. Like when we offer other people grace when we don't return a snarky comment. We offer them grace when we forgive them for a wrong done against us. In all of those situations, we don't give the other person what they deserve.

GRACE is important because God offered us grace by sending Jesus to die on the cross. Sin separates us from God. We can never bridge the gap between us and God created by our SIN. However, grace means that God sent Jesus to die in our place and rise again so that the gap between us and God could be closed forever. He has taken our punishment or consequence for all of our wrong doings. We don't deserve for Him to do that, but He loves us so much He decided to give us grace anyway.

We don't live in a world where grace is practiced a lot among people. Because of this, we often don't expect to receive grace from others or from God. In some ways we're right to think of ourselves as unworthy of God's grace. We are sinful and we do mess up again and again. Truthfully, humanity is a mess. But Psalm 103:13 says, "As a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on his faithful followers." We aren't deserving of God's love, but he lavishes it on us anyway. It's not because of who we are, but because of who He is. We must live our lives in such a way that the world sees God's grace through us.

It is because of God's grace that we can have the Holy Spirit in us, that we can be made strong, that we have God's power in us. Show the world the grace that has been given to you, not by your might but by God's.

PRAY

Lord, thank You for giving us grace even when You know the darkest parts of our hearts. Thank You for dying for us and taking our punishment. In Jesus' Name, Amen.





The Grace Race




